



### GLASGOW AND MALAWI

Glasgow City Council has been working with Malawi since 2004.

Our projects are aimed at improving the lives of Malawians in the context of health and education.

Since 2004, in partnership with City Building, we have built a HIV/Aids Clinic at Chikwawa District Hospital and refurbished a public health clinic in Lilongwe.

Working in partnership with the charity 500 Miles, we have also built a prosthetics and orthotics clinic at Kamuzu Central Hospital in Lilongwe.

We also provide IT equipment to schools, colleges, universities, hospitals and local government offices and each year, take a team out to Malawi to install the IT equipment and deliver IT training.

As a result of Glasgow's commitment to ensuring as many people as possible have access to IT, the subject is now on the national curriculum in schools.
