

Donations from Glasgow City Council

to

Prison Services, Malawi

Over the last few years we have donated IT equipment to the Police and the Prison Services in Malawi. Some of this work was carried out in co-operation with Police Scotland.

In the course of our visits this year, we were able to re-visit the Prison Headquarters at Zomba, and Maula Prison in Lilongwe.

A substantial donation of sports clothing had been received by the Lord Provost's Malawi Project and it was decided to pass on the goods to the various prisons. The Prison Services were made aware of the possibility of being given some of the available sports uniforms and they expressed their gratitude in advance.

The container which left Glasgow on 30<sup>th</sup> October is scheduled to arrive in Malawi before the end of the year. The Prison Services have been contacted and made aware that the goods are now on route. The shipment comprises a total of 679 boxes.

The sports uniforms will be put to use at prisons and young offenders institutions in Zomba, Blantyre and Lilongwe.
